We, the organizers of Earth Day Indonesia 2020, would like to invite you to participate in **The Hope March:** a peaceful demonstration lead by our children with the aim to claim for climate action.

This march takes place prior to D-day (Earth Day is on April 22nd). The activity should be internally organized by the parties who commit to its accomplishment. We, Earth Day Indonesia 2020 organizers, do not provide funding and/or resources but the concept for the event development as well as technical guidance to bring Earth Day outputs in one voice toward the need for climate change response.

Children are the flag of the event. So they should be in the frontline leading the march and communicating the message in their own way.

**DATE:** 19 April 2020

**TIME:** From 07.00 to 09.00am

**PLACE:** Meeting point at MONAS (Silang MONAS Barat Daya). Ending point at Deutsche Bank building for a walk of approximately 2.5 km.

## TIPS TO PREPARE FOR THE EVENT:

- Brief the children (according to group age) about the motto of the march: Why are they marching, what are they demanding, and to whom?
- Encourage them to prepare their own materials to support the march: banners, flags and/or dress codes.
- Ensure safety and protection of children, particularly the early years children.
- Bring your own tumbler and snacks and avoid single-serve plastic. This is a minimal waste event.
